

What can a traineeship do for your business?

What is a traineeship?

A traineeship is where your employment combines work and structured on the job training, registered with the NSW Department of Education and Training (DET)

Who is eligible?

There are some criteria to meet:

- ✓ Australian Citizen or permanent resident
- ✓ Does not already hold a formal qualification



Who are they for?

Traineeships are available for both new and existing workers of any age. There is support and financial incentives from both the Commonwealth and State Governments.

How does it work?

The state government will meet the cost of tuition fees for eligible new employees (within 3 months of full-time employment). Employers are entitled to receive up to \$4000 incentives for both new and existing workers. Upon enrolment there is a compulsory enrolment fee to be paid. (approx \$400) Depending on the certificate level and hours worked, training may take up to 2 years. On completion you may be eligible to continue to the next level certificate.

Your trainee will receive:

- ✓ Flexible training delivered completely in the workplace, part-time
- ✓ Customised to meet your needs
- ✓ Nationally recognised qualification that easily links to further vocational education and training and university studies.
